Thank you for your commitment to supporting missionaries who are following Christ's call around the globe. It is an investment in people that is producing a harvest of lives transformed.








NEW MISSIONARIES & INTERNS TRAINED

Initially the thought of raising support was terrifying to me and Alainna, but we knew God was leading us into a ministry context at Virginia Tech that would require it. The staff at Reliant gave us the practical tools and theological understanding to not just ask people for money, but to truly invite people into a partnership with our ministry and what God is doing. The help we received didn't stop after the initial staff training either. I have spent hours on the phone catching up with, being encouraged by, or getting a variety of questions answered by people in the Reliant office. The support that Reliant offers has allowed us to more fully focus on doing what God has called us to do at our local church, NLCF at Virginia Tech.

The freedom of mobility that Reliant gives is another huge blessing. In 2020 Alainna and I, Morgan and Enrique Solorzano, and Margaret Davis will be planting a church at Penn State. NLCF asked us to be on the church plant team and Reliant makes it so that financially we can transition to a new state, start a new church, and step into new roles while maintaining our current ministry team. Reliant's backing gives us one less thing to worry about as we follow God's exciting new direction for us. If you couldn't already tell, I'm happy to be a Reliant Missionary and I think the Kingdom of God is expanding because of their work.

My name is Aldin Fafulovic and I am an international campus missionary with Reliant. A couple years ago the Lord awakened a passion within me to reach local and international students at Eastern Michigan University, Although I am originally from Bosnia and served there for a while, God used relationships, loss, grief, sacrifice, and a load of last minute miracles to get me to Ypsilanti, Ml. As I've built relationships and have observed the crucial need for the gospel to be proclaimed in this town and the EMU campus, I've been led to join the whole-heartedly committed staff team at New Life Church, and use the ways God has gifted me to invest in His Kingdom here.



Discovering that there's a large population of internationals here, my passion to invest on this field kept growing, EMU has 1000 international students from 80 countries around the world who need to be exposed to the gospel. It's exciting that there's a possibility to boldly and wisely proclaim to many nations that they CAN be forgiven, and loved, and be reunited with their Creator eternally through Christ without having to earn His love, but receive the precious gift of grace! I'm humbled by the impact on the lives of students from China, South Asia, Europe, Saudi Arabia, and locals. A melting pot of young students who get to hear the gospel, receive Jesus as their foundation and go out to make more disciples that multiply for God's glory and Kingdom.
